

CONTEXT CLUES

Inference

The patient was reluctant to sign the informed consent form, hesitating and asking many questions before agreeing. (Inference: "Reluctant" means hesitant or unwilling.)

Synonym

The doctor emphasized the importance of autonomy, or independence, in making healthcare decisions. (Synonym: "Autonomy" is explained as "independence.")

IDEAS

Definition

The patient bill of rights, a document outlining the rights of patients, ensures they receive respectful and fair treatment. (Definition: "Patient bill of rights" is defined as a document outlining patient rights.)

Example

Ethical behavior, such as maintaining patient confidentiality and obtaining informed consent, is critical in healthcare. (Example: "Ethical behavior" is clarified by examples like confidentiality and informed consent.)

Antonym

Unlike unethical practices, such as falsifying patient records, ethical behavior ensures trust in healthcare. (Antonym: "Unethical" is the opposite of "ethical.")
